

## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Directors Charge Only)</b>	£1,780
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£495
Collection and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£250
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises	$\pm_{335}$
Providing a suitable coffin - this will be made from wood effect foil veneer	£250
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£100
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£350
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b> This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself. <b>Burial (funeral director's charge only)</b> <b>Cremation (funeral director's charge plus the cremation fee)</b>	Not offered £1,300

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave. <sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
